



BEFORE THE HURRICANE

1. Line up bulk fuel suppliers
2. Warn your business credit card companies
3. Plan for temporary fleet yards
4. Business services need to be planned
5. Make sure personnel is ready



HURRICANE IS HERE

1. Double & triple check preparedness
2. Before landfall, top off fuel tanks
3. At landfall, get fuel delivered ASAP
4. Speak to fuel rep about expected impacts
5. Be flexible & be patient

HURRICANE FACTS

1. Hurricane Season starts June 1st in the Atlantic and May 15th in the Pacific; both end Nov 30th.
2. Hurricanes unleash 2.4 trillion gallons of water per day with wind speeds upwards of 160 mph.
3. Hurricanes rotate in a counter clockwise direction around the eye.
4. Every second, a large hurricane releases the energy of 10 atomic bombs.
5. Jupiter has a hurricane which has been going for over 300 years and is bigger than the Earth.
